### I. Description and Readings

We will be studying modal logic, the logic of necessity and possibility. If there is time, we will also study the metaphysics of modality, the metaphysics of necessity and possibility. When studying modal logic, we will read parts of David Braun's manuscript *Logical Methods in Philosophy*. The relevant parts of the manuscript will be available somehow. If we study the metaphysics of modality, other readings will be made available to you. A schedule will be posted and updated on the course webpage. You will be expected to have done the readings before class and to bring the relevant texts with you.

### II. Requirements

The course grade will be based on at least three and no more than six short assignments. You will have at least one week to complete each assignment. Participation can help (but not hurt) your grade.
